**50-DAY MISSION**  
**PRAYER FOCUS**

***The purpose of this 50-Day Mission Prayer Focus is to give you some direction in your praying prior to and in the immediate period after the ASK mission 27<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup> June 20..***

***Prayer is not just preparation for the work. PRAYER IS THE WORK!***

The slickest promotion campaigns, best meeting facilities, largest crowds and most experienced and energetic speakers are no guarantee of the blessing of God. We are not to be satisfied with exciting events. *We must settle for nothing less than an outpouring of the Spirit of God.*

*'Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes may have eternal life in Him.'* John 3:14-15

*'And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself.'* John 12:32

We believe that as the name of Jesus is lifted up over this event in worship, loving acts of kindness and the anointed preaching of God's Word that He will do what He has promised and draw men, women, young people and children to Him. Our only desire is to **see lives impacted and transformed by an encounter with the living Jesus.**

Prayer is like the air strikes that pave the way for the ground troops to move in and gather the spoils of war. May the Lord fill your heart with praise and adoration to the Lord Jesus Christ as you fervently pray for this mission and then watch the great things God does at the event itself!

| Day 1 May 22 <sup>nd</sup> | Pray that the local hosting team would have ears open to Father God's voice & direction and would not lean on their own understanding [Isaiah 50:4-5; Proverbs 3:5-6].   |
| Day 2 May 23 <sup>rd</sup> | Pray that all those involved [local and visiting teams] would make spending time in God's presence and drawing closer to Him their first priority [Revelation 2:1-5].  |
| Day 3 May 24 <sup>th</sup> | Pray that all those involved [local and visiting teams] would walk in freedom, truth, righteousness, holiness and love before the Lord and in openness, humility and love with one another [2Corinthians 6:14-7:1].  |
| Day 4 May 25 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for Father God's wisdom, counsel, revelation and discernment in all decision making [James 1:5-8; Philippians 1:9-11].  |
| Day 5 May 26 <sup>th</sup> | Pray that there would be unity and harmony manifested in the lives of all those participating especially in their homes, families and with one another [John 17:20-23; Philippians 2:1-4].   |
| Day 6 May 27 <sup>th</sup> | Plead the blood of Jesus for complete protection from the attacks of the enemy for all those involved. Include physical, mental and spiritual strength, health and well-being as well as freedom from all accusing voices & deceptive thoughts [John 17:11, 15-17; 2 Thessalonians 3:2-3]. |
| Day 7 May 28 <sup>th</sup> | Ask the Holy Spirit to come and brood over the people of the Eden Valley so that they begin to hunger and thirst for Him [Matthew 5:6].  |
| Day 8 May 29 <sup>th</sup> | Pray that those who step onto the mission field will be filled with a longing to know Jesus [2Corinthians 6:1-2].  |
| Day 9 May 30 <sup>th</sup> | Plead the blood of Jesus over all those who will attend the mission. Pray protection from illness, injury and other distracting influences that might keep them from attending [Psalm 27:1-3; 34:7].   |

| Day 10 May 31 <sup>st</sup> | Pray that the minds of those who attend the meetings will be released from all mental and spiritual restriction in order to hear and receive God's Word [2Corinthians 10:3-4; 11:2-3].                            |
| Day 11 June 1 <sup>st</sup> | Pray that God will prepare the heart and spirit of each attendee: that the Holy Spirit will touch each one, revealing the truth of the gospel and setting them free to follow Jesus wholeheartedly [Romans 1:16]. |
| Day 12 June 2 <sup>nd</sup> | Pray that the smokescreen of blindness the enemy has placed over the minds of the unbelievers is blown away by the breath of the Spirit and they see Jesus [2Corinthians 4:4-5].                                  |
| Day 13 June 3 <sup>rd</sup> | Pray that those who receive Jesus will continue to walk in truth and freedom in the days that follow [1Peter 1:13-17; 2Peter 1:2-11].   |
| Day 14 June 4 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for all restricting and controlling strongholds in the lives of those making commitments to be torn down [2Corinthians 10:3-5].  |
| Day 15 June 5 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for all those teaching or proclaiming God's Word to adults, young people or children. Pray they will have close, intimate, holy walks with Jesus.  |
| Day 16 June 6 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for the speakers as they prepare their messages before God. Pray for wisdom, discernment and total reliance upon the Holy Spirit both in preparation and proclamation [Proverbs 3:5-6; John 15:5].           |
| Day 17 June 7 <sup>th</sup> | Pray all speakers will have great sensitivity to gentle nuances of the Spirit's leading and great power to speak the truth in love [Zechariah 4:6; Ephesians 4:15].   |
| Day 18 June 8 <sup>th</sup> | Plead the blood of Jesus for complete health and safety for all speakers, their families and for unity and harmony in their home life [Psalm 18:1-3; 1Peter 4:8].   |
| Day 19 June 9 <sup>th</sup> | Plead the blood of Jesus for protection over the lives and families of EVERYONE involved in the mission. Ask the Holy Spirit to raise levels of faith and re-energise those                                       |

|                              | who are getting tired. Pray against the enemy sowing seeds of doubt, discouragement, accusing thoughts, contention, disunity and all forms of temptation. [Matthew 26:41; Romans 15:13].   |
| Day 20 June 10 <sup>th</sup> | Plead the protection of the blood of Jesus over the locations where meetings will take place: two fields in Brough, St Michael's Church, Brough Parish Hall and various local schools. Pray especially that they be set apart for God's Spirit alone to move and influence [2Timothy 2:20-21]. |
| Day 21 June 11 <sup>th</sup> | Plead the blood of Jesus over all technical equipment: sound system, lights, projectors, amplification etc. [Proverbs 2:6-8].  |
| Day 22 June 12 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for those preparing to lead worship: for great sensitivity to the Holy Spirit's leading and that they might not draw attention off glorifying Jesus onto themselves [Ephesians 5:18-21; John 16:13-14].   |
| Day 23 June 13 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for a release of great joy in worship that welcomes and creates a habitation for the glory of God to descend across the field and fill the tent [2Chronicles 5:13-14].  |
| Day 24 June 14 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for a release of the spirit of grace, worship, prayer & intercession in and amongst the prayer house team as they minister before the Lord 24 hours a day throughout the event [1Kings 8:11; Zechariah 12:10].  |
| Day 25 June 15 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for needy people to have the courage and humility to come forward for prayer. Pray that they receive Jesus. Pray they will be partnered with the right person in order to receive the follow-up help they may need [1Peter 5:5-7; 2Timothy 1:7].  |
| Day 26 June 16 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for wisdom, sensitivity to the Spirit and awareness of individual needs for those overseeing the follow up. Pray people will be connected with the right buddies [2Timothy 2:23-26].  |

| Day 27 June 17 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for real bonds of unity in the Spirit and godly friendships to be formed and/or strengthened through the mission; especially between visiting and local teams, believers and the non-believing community and across the Body of Christ in Upper Eden [Hebrews 3:12-13; 10:24-25; Romans 15:5-7].                  |
| Day 28 June 18 <sup>th</sup> | Agree with us in prayer that all attempts by the enemy to stop the conference and distract those being drawn from attending would be stopped today [1John 3:8; 4:4].   |
| Day 29 June 19 <sup>th</sup> | Pray that EVERY PERSON setting foot on one of the fields or in any of the other mission venues might have an encounter with Jesus [John 8:32-36].  |
| Day 30 June 20 <sup>th</sup> | There are a great many little jobs to be done and opportunities to serve what God is doing. Pray for a spirit of excellence to be in every act of service [great or small] and for more labourers to be raised up as the start of the mission approaches [Matthew 9:35-38].  |
| Day 31 June 21 <sup>st</sup> | Pray for all mission team leaders: speakers, youth, children, prayer house, response, visitation and follow up, worship, hospitality and field organisation. Pray for unity, clarity in communication and much joy, fun and laughter in the service of the King [Ephesians 6:18; Colossians 4:3; 1Thessalonians 5:17]. |
| Day 32 June 22 <sup>nd</sup> | Pray for God to pour His love into the hearts of every team member and volunteer. Pray He will bind all hearts together in love and that His living water might flow out to influence and impact those setting foot on the mission field [Ephesians 4:29-5:2].   |
| Day 33 June 23 <sup>d</sup>  | Pray for the wisdom and discernment to resolve any difficulties or problems that arise quickly, easily and in a godly way. Pray for a good flow of communication between the mission field team and the prayer house and vice versa [Isaiah 43:1-2].   |

| Day 34 June 24 <sup>th</sup> | The mission has been a long-time in preparation; pray for perseverance, increased strength, raised faith and the energizings of the Holy Spirit for all those involved [Isaiah 40:28-31; 1Corinthians 15:58; Galatians 6:9-10].  |
| Day 35 June 25 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for those who are deeply troubled, in fear or anxious in their spirit; those who may be seeking an answer to an inner heart-cry. Pray that they might find complete love, acceptance, security and freedom in Jesus (1John 4:18; Ephesians 6:2-3).  |
| Day 36 June 26 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for those delivering leaflets around the villages of Upper Eden today. Pray that every divine encounter will be recognised and the moment seized to speak and pray with people [Ephesians 1:15-21].<br>Pray for the Prayer House team who begin their 24 hour worship & prayer vigil today until Monday.      |
| Day 37 June 27 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for the teams going into schools today to take assemblies. Pray for the youth event this evening. Pray that the Lord would do far beyond what we could ever ask or imagine: may He touch individuals, families, church families and entire communities through the mission [Jeremiah 33:2-3; Ephesians 3:20]. |
| Day 38 June 28 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for those visiting the mission zone today: the car boot, family fun events, St Michael's prayer labyrinth or the evening tent meeting. Pray for all team members to have renewed boldness to communicate the heart and love to God's message with those they meet [Acts 1:8; 2Timothy 4:1-4].                 |
| Day 39 June 29 <sup>th</sup> | Pray for an outpouring of God's blessing to be evident on the field and in the meetings today. Give thanks with us for an abundance of God's provision to meet every need [physical, emotional, mental, spiritual and financial] [Philippians 4:19; Matthew 7:7-11].   |

| Day 40 June 30 <sup>th</sup>                         | Pray for all local church and ministry leaders; especially that they may have godly wisdom to know how to build on the momentum and spiritual renewal God has begun this weekend in Upper Eden [James 1:5-7].   |
| Days 41 – 50 July 1 <sup>st</sup> – 10 <sup>th</sup> | Please pray every day for those who have committed or rededicated their lives to Jesus over the weekend. May they choose to pursue Jesus and through discipleship go on to become rooted and grounded in God's love. Pray for the visitation team as they make house calls and begin the work of discipleship during these vital 10 days [Ephesians 3:14-19]. |
